CRITERIA FOR THE A1 JUDGING LIST:

Judges who have previously been approved to award CCs in a given breed and have carried out the appointment.

CRITERIA FOR THE A2 JUDGING LIST:

Judges who, if invited to Judge by a society, would in principle be approved by the Kennel Club to award CCs in a given breed for that occasion.

CRITERIA FOR THE A3 JUDGING LIST:

Breed Specialists

1. To have owned and exhibited Finnish Lapphunds for a minimum of seven years and to have the support of the Finnish Lapphund Club of Great Britain. (K.C. Policy)
2. To have judged Finnish Lapphunds in breed classes for a minimum of seven years. (K.C. Policy)
3. To have judged a minimum of 20 classes with at least 40 dogs present over a reasonable geographic area.
4. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on the points of the dog assessment. (K.C. Policy)
5. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the relevant examination on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures, where applicable. (K.C. Policy)
6. To have attended at least two breed specific seminars run in accordance with the K C Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and /or assessment where applicable.(K.C. policy)
7. To have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs of any breed when they first obtained their 1st entry in the KC Stud Book. (K.C. Policy)
8. To have stewarded over a minimum of 12 days at shows. (K.C. policy)
9. To have judged a Breed Club Open Show, or "supported show" or the Finnish Lapphund at Championship Level, without CC's. Minimum of 8 classes.

Non Specialists

1. To have a minimum of seven years judging experience in any one breed and have the support of The Finnish Lapphund Club of Great Britain. (K.C. Policy)
2. To have judged Finnish Lapphunds in Breed classes for a minimum of five years.(K.C. Policy)
3. To have judged a minimum of 20 classes with at least 40 dogs present over a reasonable geographic area.
4. To have attended at least two breed specific seminars run in accordance with the KC Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment, where applicable.
5. To be KC approved to award CC's in at least one other breed. (K.C. Policy)
6. To have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs of any breed when they obtained their 1st entry in the KC Stud Book. (K.C. Policy)
7. To have judged a Breed Open Show, or a "supported show" or the Finnish Lapphund at Championship Level, without CC's Minimum 12 classes.

* Judges who are approved to award CCs in more than 3 breeds are exempt from passing a hands-on assessment (KC Policy)

Achievement of the above criteria will not mean automatic selection to a list.
